NAGR Members Pressure Texas Legislators to Pass Pro-Gun Bills

The National Association for Gun Rights (NAGR) is urging its members and supporters in Texas to contact their legislative leaders to pass HB-19 and SB-21 before the special session ends in late July.

NAGR has let their members and supporters know that these two bills will further protect their rights by prohibiting state officials from enforcing federal gun laws and removing government imposed "criminal safezones."

"Texans have the power to influence their legislators' and get pro-gun bills passed for their state," said Dudley Brown, Executive Vice President of the National Association for Gun Rights. "If Texas state legislators fail to act, they'll be leaving Texans' gun rights at the mercy of a power-hungry and scandal-ridden Obama administration for the next two years."

So far, these bills have been ignored by Lieutenant Governor Dewhurst and Speaker of the House Strauss. NAGR is committed to keeping the pressure on these legislators. It is imperative that Texas legislators don't get away with simply sweeping these bills under the rug.
