### **Recall Efforts a Win for Colorado Gun Owners**

The National Association for Gun Rights (NAGR) touts the successful recall of State Senators John Morse and Angela Giron as a monumental win for Colorado gun owners and constitutionalists nationwide.

In direct defiance of the wishes of their constituents, Morse and Giron passed radical, anti-gun bills in the Colorado Legislature this year. As a result, the grassroots efforts of Coloradans resulted in the first-ever recall in the State's history.
