NAGR is proud to support Rep. Massie's efforts to block the ammo ban

Fredericksburg, Va.- The National Association for Gun Rights is proud to stand with Congressman Thomas Massie in his preemptive efforts to stop any future attempts from the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives on the Ammo Ban.

Thomas Massie is introducing multiple amendments that will strip the BATF's ability to block specific types of ammunition.

"The Massie amendment would protect honest law abiding citizens from any more radical attempts by the BATF to block the sale of .223 ammunition," said NAGR President Dudley Brown.

Following an attempted ban earlier this year by the BATF on the manufacture, sale, and importation of M855, a common type of ammunition used in AR-15's, pro-gun members of Congress have been working to block any future attempts.

"We are proud to stand by Congressman Massie as he fights for our Second Amendment rights," said NAGR President Dudley Brown, "it's no surprise so many gun owners are supporting Massie by calling their Representative and urging them to support the Massie amendment H.R. 2578."

Massie's proposal is an amendment to the annual Commerce, Justice, and Science Appropriations Bill that would ensure that the BATF will have no authority to promulgate restrictions on common types of ammunition. The National Association for Gun Rights is thrilled that Congressman Thomas Massie is supporting our right to keep and bear arms by working to block any future attempts to restrict the type of ammunition we use.
